1. Apologies for Absence

2. Members' Declarations of Interest

The Council resolved that consideration is referred to the Grants to Voluntary Organisations Committee.

It was **recommended** that

(1) the sum of £4,000 is awarded to this project from within General Reserves (Local Government Act 1972 s. 145).

(2) the Council considers the establishment of an additional fund to help support community organisations from outside of the voluntary sector, as part of the preparation of the 2022/23 budget.
