5. Provisional Programme of Events

- (1) At a meeting held on 15 December 2021 the Council resolved that the Community Celebration Dinner is not staged this year, with financial savings arising being used to support local Foodbanks (Local Government Act 2000 s 2 (Power of Well-being)).
- (2) At a meeting to be held on 9 February 2022 the Council will consider whether the Primary Schools Festival, which is to be held remotely this year, with any financial savings being used to support local music-related charities, should be brought forward to avoid staging the event during the forthcoming Pre-Election Period. The decision of Council will be reported.
