**1 Apologies for Absence**

The minutes of the meeting held on 5 September 2022 were confirmed as a correct record. The Chair signed the minutes.

**4 Playschemes 2022**

Members were pleased to receive a report and video presentation from Councillor Julian Davenne on the Summer Programme of activities for this year's summer Playschemes.

The presentation showed the variety of activities available at various locations including schools, Cwmbran Stadium and local parks and included indoor and

outdoor activities. The program also included swimming at Cwmbran Stadium.

The video included training of volunteers, who put in a great deal of time and effort and worked extremely hard. The playschemes helps the volunteers to gain confidence through team building activities, with a number of volunteers taking part for a number of years, to then move on to careers using the new skills they have gained and developed.

Councillor Davenne reported on the inclusion of all children and the provisions in place to assist them to take part.

Members commented and applauded Councillor Davenne on the excellent work and organisation of the Playschemes.

## **5 Remembrance Service for Her Late Majesty Queen Elizabeth II**

Members were pleased with the attendance at the Remembrance Service organised at less than a weeks' notice. All members were invited to attend the event which took place on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> September 2022 outside Cwmbran Community Council offices.

Members noted that Councillor Bird welcomed all to the ceremony and paid tribute to the late Queen, followed by a blessing and message from Reverend Cannon Harald Thomas MBE. The ceremony was attended by pupils from Our Lady's of the Angels Primary School and representatives from local Police, Fire Service and military groups.

## **6 Senior Schools Choral Festival**

The Acting Clerk updated members on the arrangements for this year's Choral Festival, which is taking place on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> October 2022 at 6pm at the Congress Theatre. Reverend Cannon Harald Thomas has offered his services as Master of Ceremonies.

The two schools taking part this year are Crownbridge and Caerleon Comprehensive School, each school has 20-30 minutes to perform. A number of local schools were invited to attend however were unable to participate as they did not have a choir at present.

Members suggested that Coleg Gwent could be invited to participate in this event in the future.

## **7 Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremonies**

The Acting Clerk updated members on the arrangements for this year's Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremonies, taking place at Ladywell, Pontnewydd, Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2022 and The Council House, Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2022 at 6pm. Reverend Cannon Harald Thomas has kindly offered his services for both Ceremonies.

Cwmbran Brass Band have confirmed their attendance at Pontnewydd and the Salvation Army will be attending the Council House Ceremonies. Trees and lighting for both venues have been ordered.

Members enquired about the removal of the scaffolding on the Council House before the Ceremonies. The Acting Clerk confirmed that the scaffolding was due to be removed in the next 2 weeks.

Tea, coffee and mince pies will be provided and selection boxes purchased for children attending. The Acting Clerk hoped that Morrisons might be able to support the event again this year by providing some selection boxes.

Councillor Morgan has spoken to members of the Harmonize Choir who will be attending informally to participate in the carol singing.

## **8 Merchandise, Gazebo & Display Boards**

The Acting Clerk informed members of the quotes received from Promocorp to replace the existing Gazebo and Display Boards.
