6. **New Applications Received**


Applications for financial assistance have been received from the following organisations. A report on each application is attached.

Details of each applicant's finances, submitted as part of each application, will be available at the meeting for members of the committee only.

Grants may be awarded using section 137 of the Local Government Act 1972, which empowers the council to spend up to a prescribed amount in any year for the direct benefit of their area or any part of it or all or some of its inhabitants. Any expenditure must be commensurate with the benefit to the community. However, where there is an existing specific statutory provision, that provision should be applied rather than s137. The attached reports indicate the power upon which the Council could rely should a grant be awarded.

Note: The Council has put in place criteria to help consider grant applications. The Council reserve the right to relax any of the criteria at its discretion.
