1. Nomination papers may be hand delivered to the Returning Officer, Civic Centre, Pontypool, Torfaen NP4 6YB or electronically as per the arrangements set out in the electronic delivery statement below.
Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesday and Thursday 9.30am - 12noon / 1.00pm - 4.30pm Friday 9.30am – 12noon / 1.00pm - 4.00pm, but no later than **4pm on 30 January 2026**.
2. Nomination papers may be obtained from the offices of the Returning Officer, Civic Centre, Pontypool, NP4 6YB during the times stated above or available from: <https://www.electoralcommission.org.uk/our-guidance/candidate-or-agent/community-council-elections-wales> where at the request of any elector for a ward a nomination paper will be prepared for signature.
3. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **26 February 2026** between **7am – 10pm**.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on **10 February 2026**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Centre, Pontypool, Torfaen NP4 6YB by 5pm on **11 February 2026**.
6. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Centre, Pontypool NP4 6YB by 5pm on **18 February 2026**.
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Centre, Pontypool, Torfaen, NP4 6YB by 5pm **26 February 2026**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on **18 February 2026**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on **18 February 2026**.
