Be Independent.

SWFRS personnel in partnership with Gwent Police and Torfaen local Service Board activities:

- Cwmbran Crews attended the launch event BE INDEPENDENT for elderly residents in the Torfean area, this was held at Ty-George Landsbury Complex. White Watch gave residents advice on fire safety and took a selection of items that were available to residents.
- Cwmbran crews have continued to promote Be Independent by intelligent targeting of low income older couples long established in former council estates, Older Tenants on low rise social housing estates where jobs are scarce and people living in social accommodation designed for older people. When visiting these premises crews are distributing Be Independent information leaflets and highlighting the targeted risks for this high risk category including peak times for kitchen / cooking fires being 8. p.m – 9.p.m.
- Doctors / Dentists and Pharmacy premises in the community to distribute “Be Independent information posters and leaflets, for an increased impact on the community.
- Crews have also delivered Fire Safety talks and promoted Be Independent to the Falls Programme in Canal Side Resource Centre.

SM Guerin continues to liaise with Police regarding deliberate fires in area, fire crime working in area.
