

Nominee Guidelines for Community Awards

Who Can Be Nominated

- Individuals who live in Cwmbran.
- People who represent an organisation operating within Cwmbran.
- Volunteers who actively contribute their time and skills in Cwmbran.
- Anyone who has made a notable or lasting difference to the Cwmbran community.

Who Cannot Be Nominated

- Current members or officers of Cwmbran Community Council.
- Anyone who has received a Community Award within the past two years.

Nomination Submission Requirements

- Provide a clear and detailed explanation for the nomination, including specific examples or evidence of the nominee's contribution. This information is essential for a strong application.
- If the nominee's work relates to their paid employment, explain how their actions have exceeded normal job expectations.

Evaluation and Decision Process

- All nominations will be reviewed and confirmed by Cwmbran Community Council.
- The Council may reassign a nomination to a more suitable category if appropriate.
- If no nominations meet the standard for a category, the Council reserves the right not to present an award in that category.

Awards Presentation

- Awards will be presented during the Community Awards Ceremony at The Parkway Hotel Friday 06.03.26
- The Chair of Cwmbran Community Council will present the awards, or in their absence, the Vice Chair will do so.
